His exploits in the jungles of Vietnam earned him Purple Hearts, Bronze Stars and a Combat Infantry Badge that he no longer wears. What he does take with him daily is a stiff, achy shoulder from an AK-47 round in 1969 that gives his golf buddies a false sense of hope when they tee it up.

Since retirement from a successful career as co-founder of a high-tech, video production business, Manning has turned his attentions to playing as much golf as possible and to a favorite non-profit organization that he helped create; USA Cares. When asked which of these two conflicting avocations was his favorite, he stated "I'm so glad that golf tournaments have proven to be such great fundraising events for non-profit organizations like USA Cares. I got to play with Pat Boone last year at the Los Angeles USA Cares scramble. Golfers are passionate about the game and don't mind paying a little more for the chance to win something or to share a beer with a celebrity on the 19th hole afterwards. I mean the whole thing is just a blast and everybody leaves knowing they did some good at the same time."

About Covered Bridge

Covered Bridge is a Fuzzy Zoeller designed 18-hole course nestled on a gently rolling plain at the foot of Southern Indiana's famous Floyds Knobs. Each hole has been laid out to emphasize the natural beauty of the landscape and panorama. The par 72 circuit features five lakes, a meandering creek and is pleasantly forested. Greens are gently contoured and trap placement is challenging but not punishing. Paved cart paths connect all tees and carts can be driven anywhere on the course's Zoysia grass fairways. Each hole offers a choice of four separate tees matching the course to the ability level of any player.
